

A Drug	A substance that when absorbed can have an effect on the body
A Medicine	Drugs that help people who are suffering from an illness or disease
Cannabis	Most widely used illegal drug in Britain. A mild sedative often causing a chilled out feeling or actual sleepiness
Cocaine	An illegal class A drug that is highly addictive. It is a stimulant and can make the heart beat faster
Heroin	A very strong illegal painkiller which slows down body functions and is highly addictive.
Steroids	Used by athletes to help them build up muscle mass quicker and be able to train harder.
Tobacco	Contains the highly addictive drug nicotine and is found in cigarettes. Can cause cancer, emphysema and heart disease.
Caffeine	A stimulant drug found in many beverages such as tea, coffee and energy drinks. Is highly addictive stimulant.
Recreational Drugs	Drugs that are taken for pleasure and serve no medical purpose.
